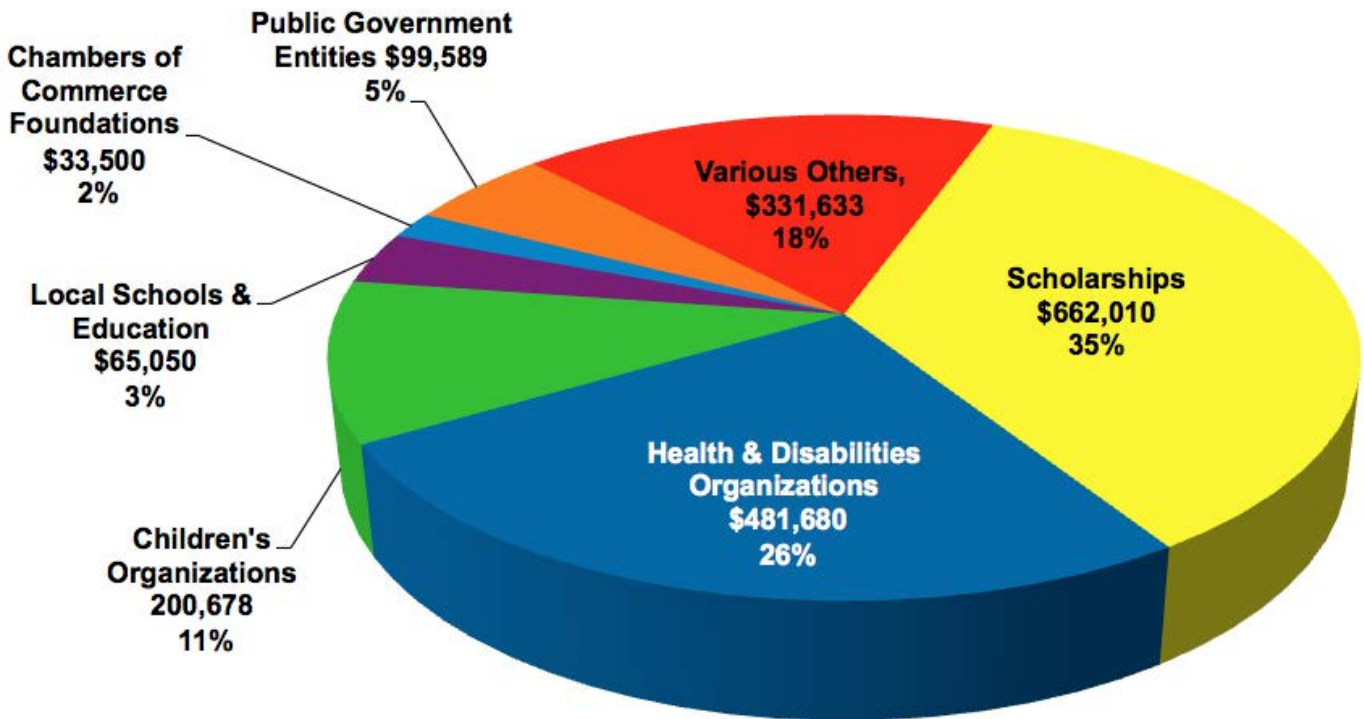

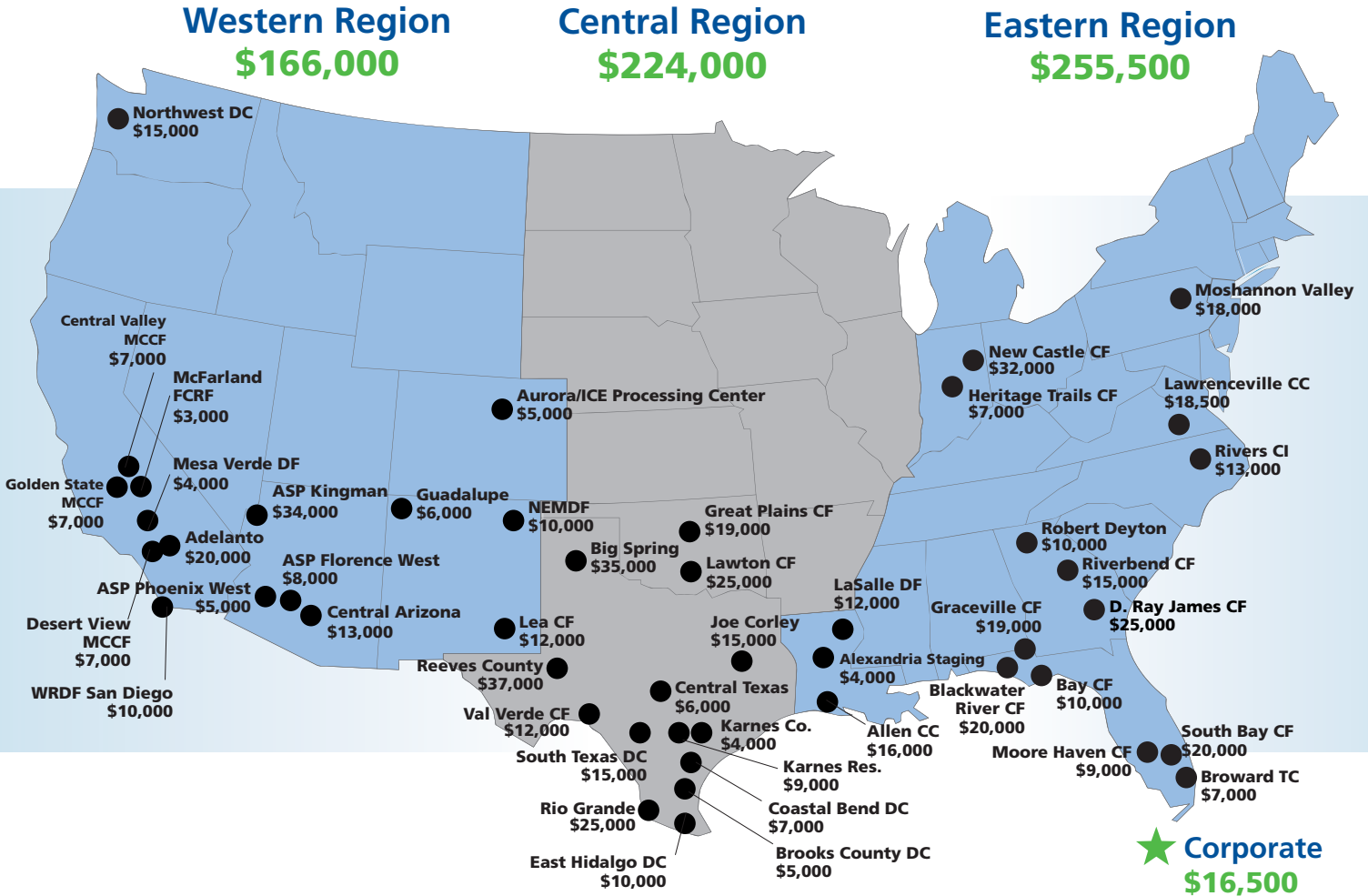


LaSalle Awards Student Scholarships

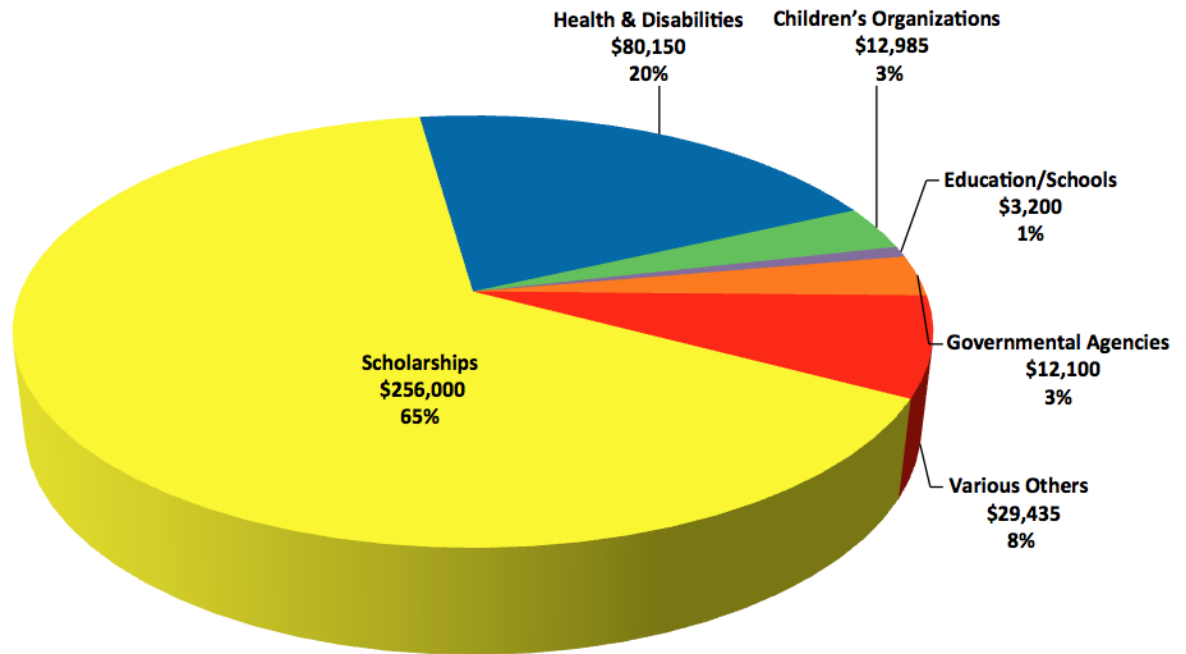
Eastern Region GEO Group Foundation Donations

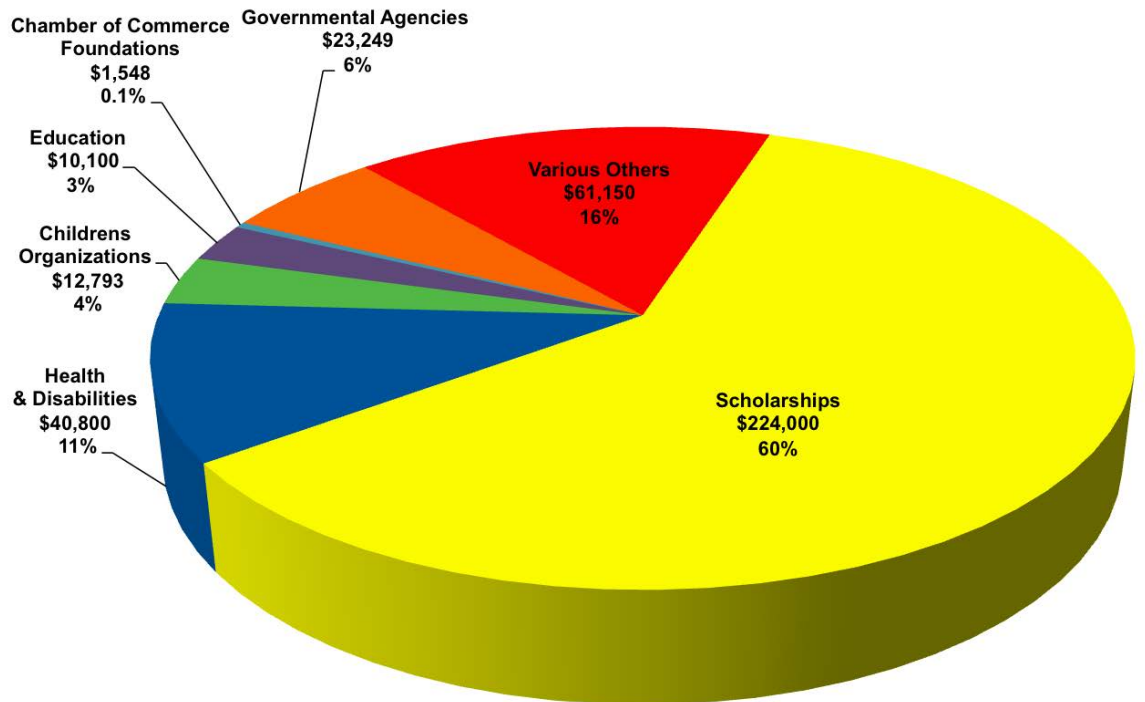
Central Region GEO Group Foundation Donations

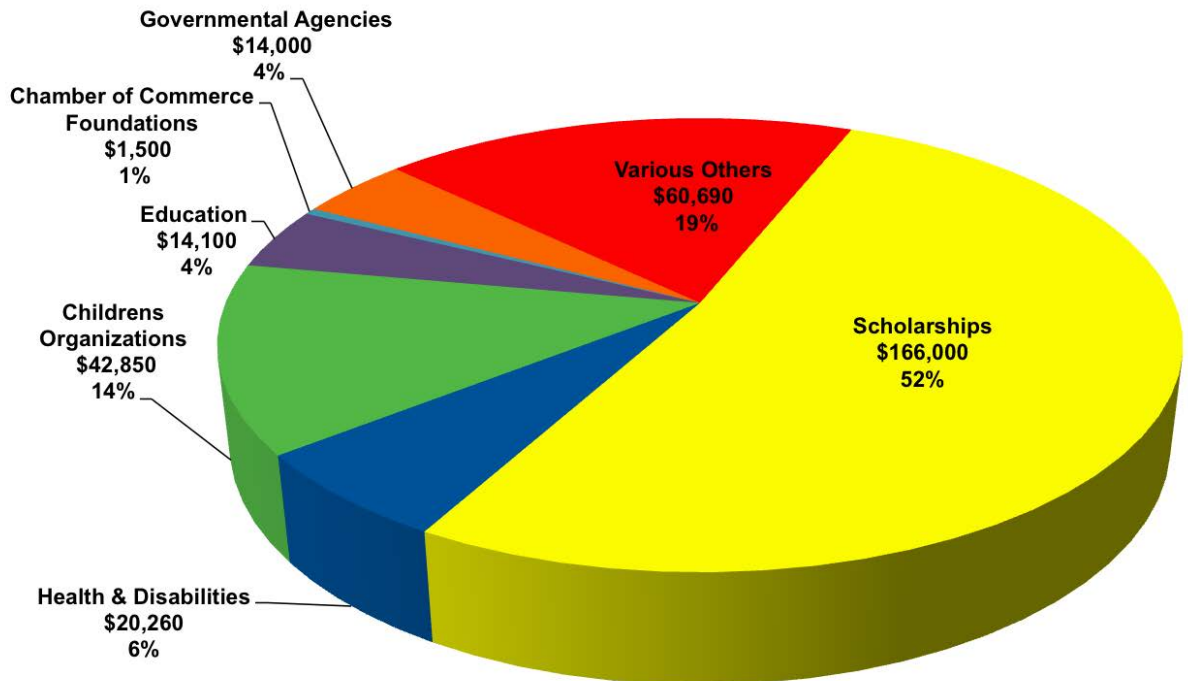
Western Region GEO Group Foundation Donations
