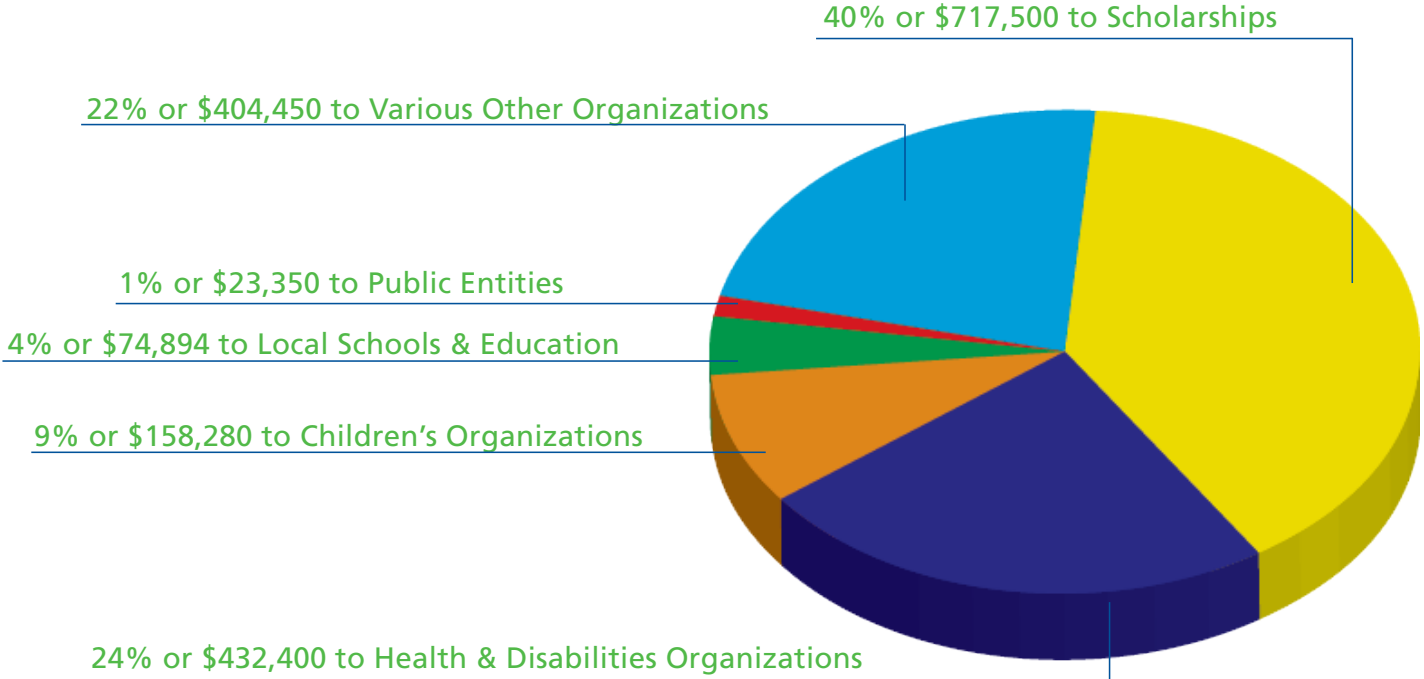

This year, we were able to give \$6,000 in scholarships to high school seniors and \$5,000 to students involved in agricultural programs such as FFA and 4-H.

HTCF Donates to Local High School Scholarship Fund

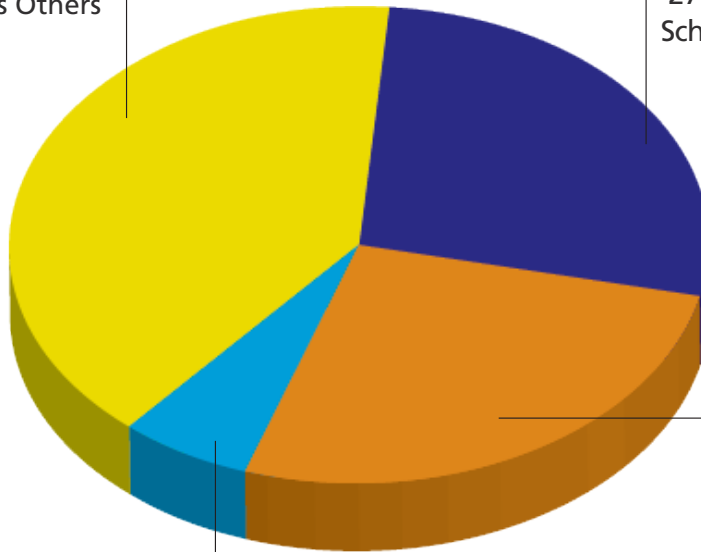

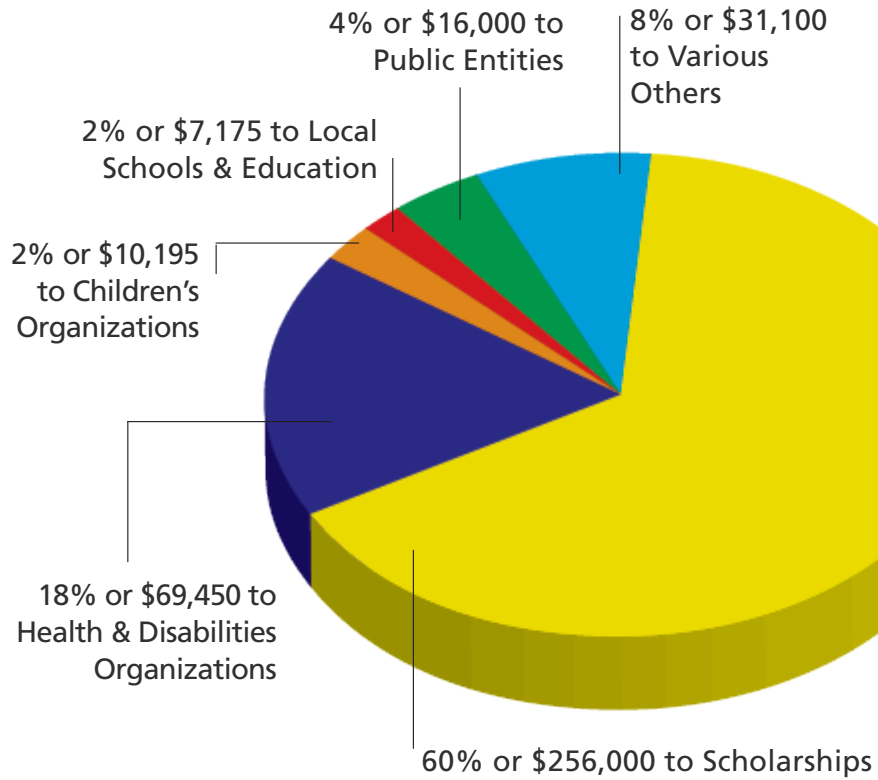

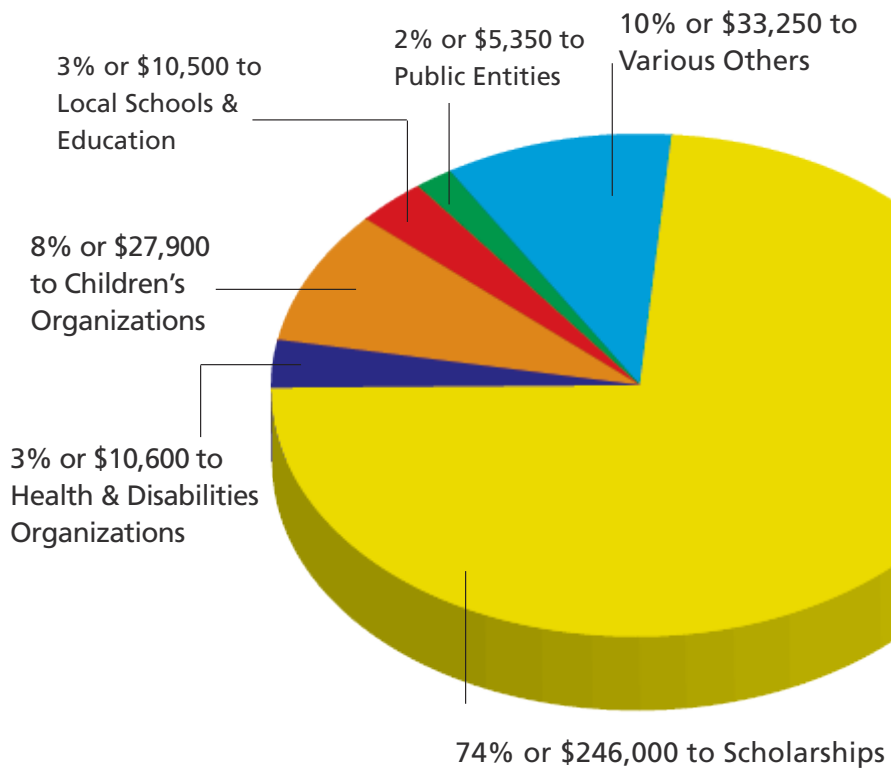
Central Region GEO Foundation Donations (As of December 31, 2020)

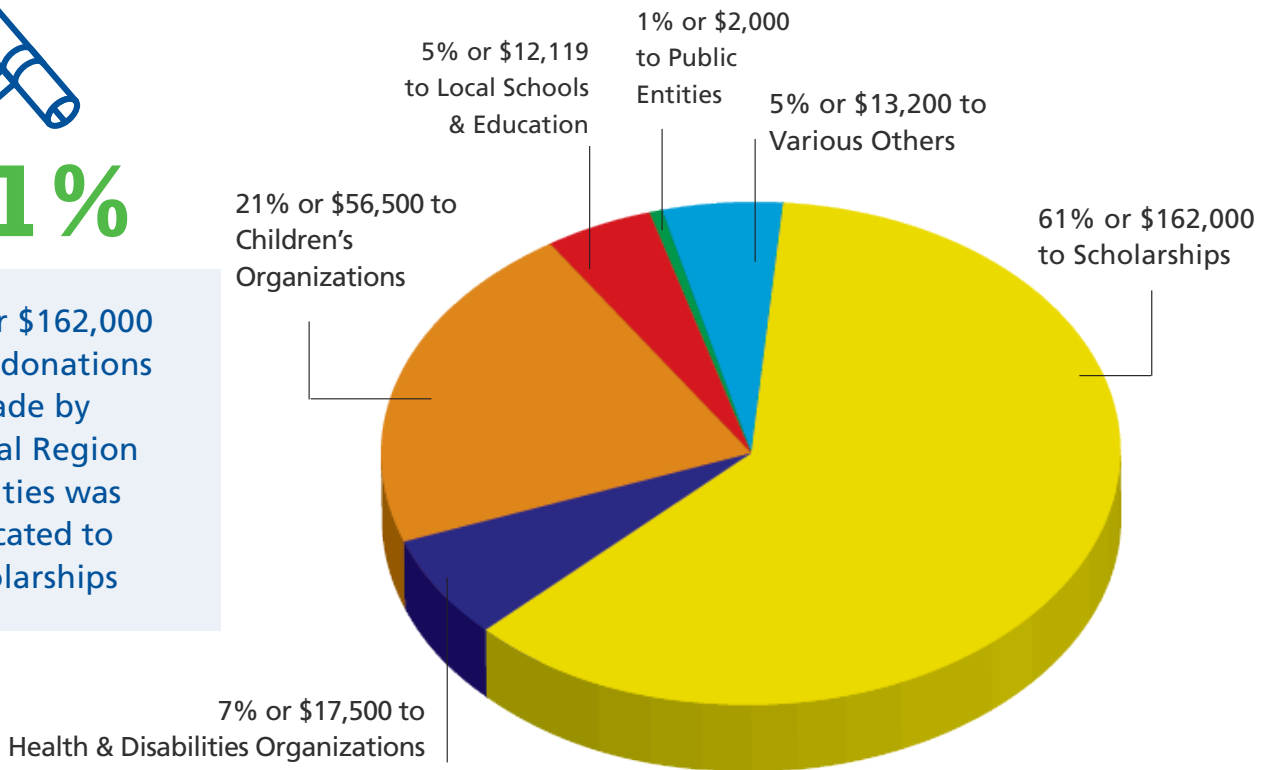
Western Region GEO Foundation Donations (As of December 31, 2020)
