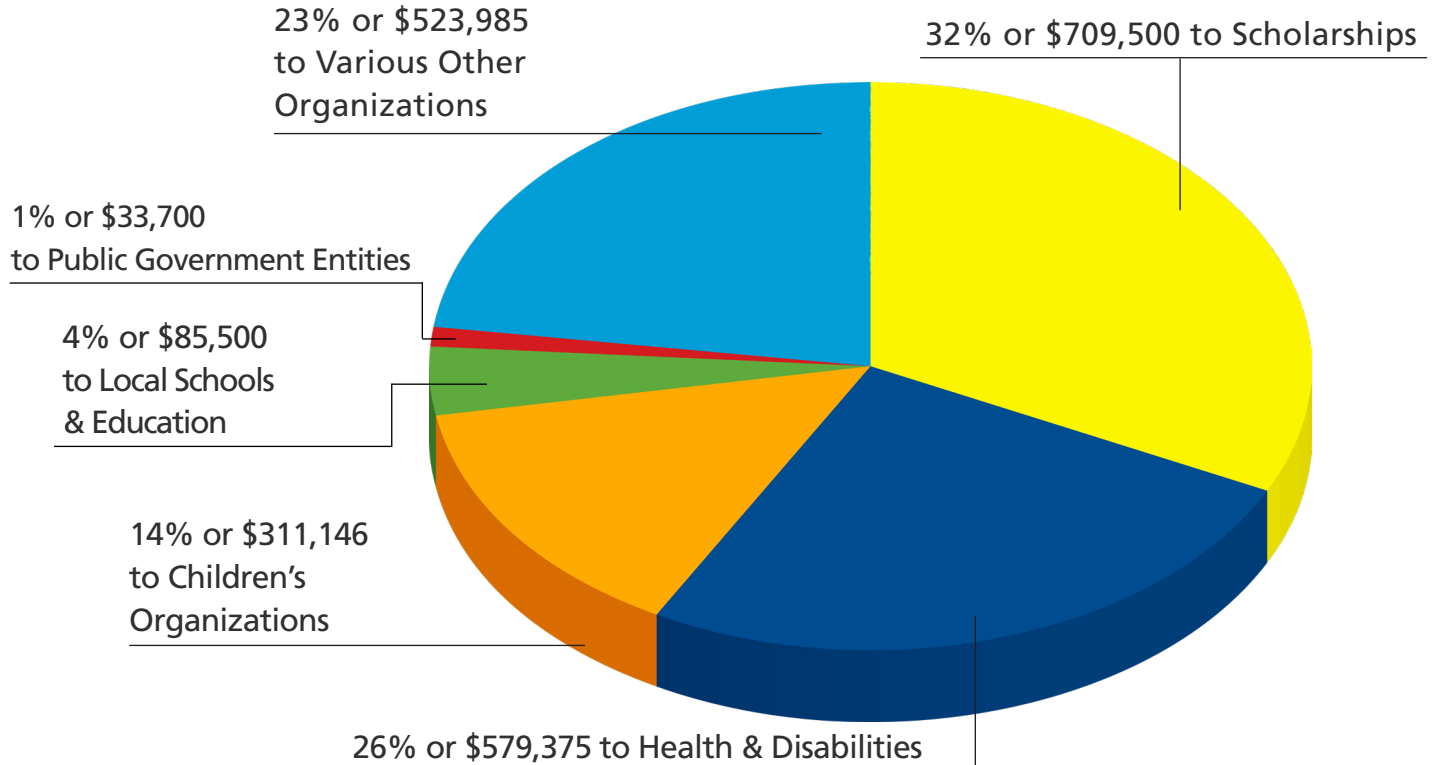

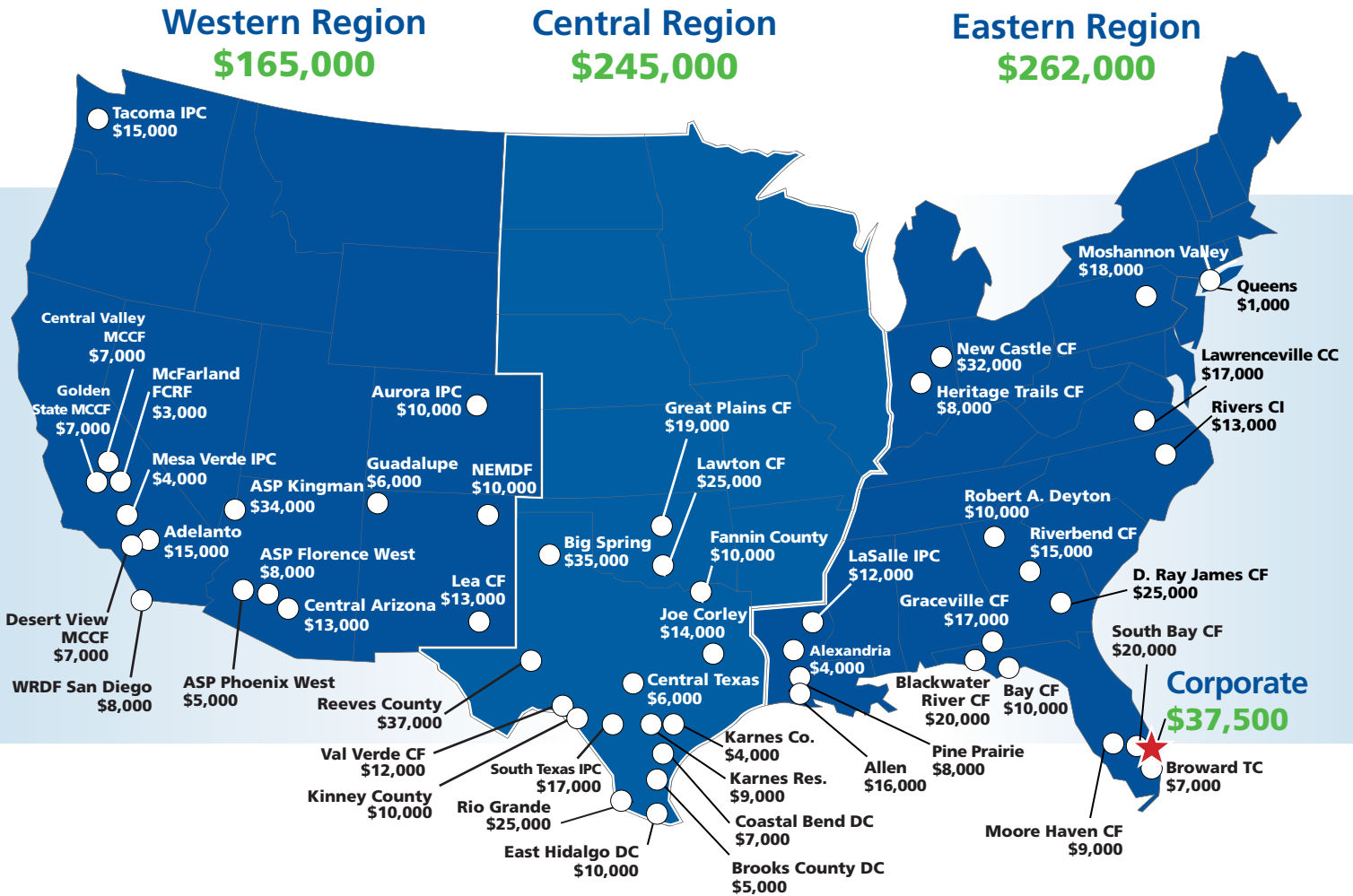


### GEO Foundation Supports Student Scholarships in AZ

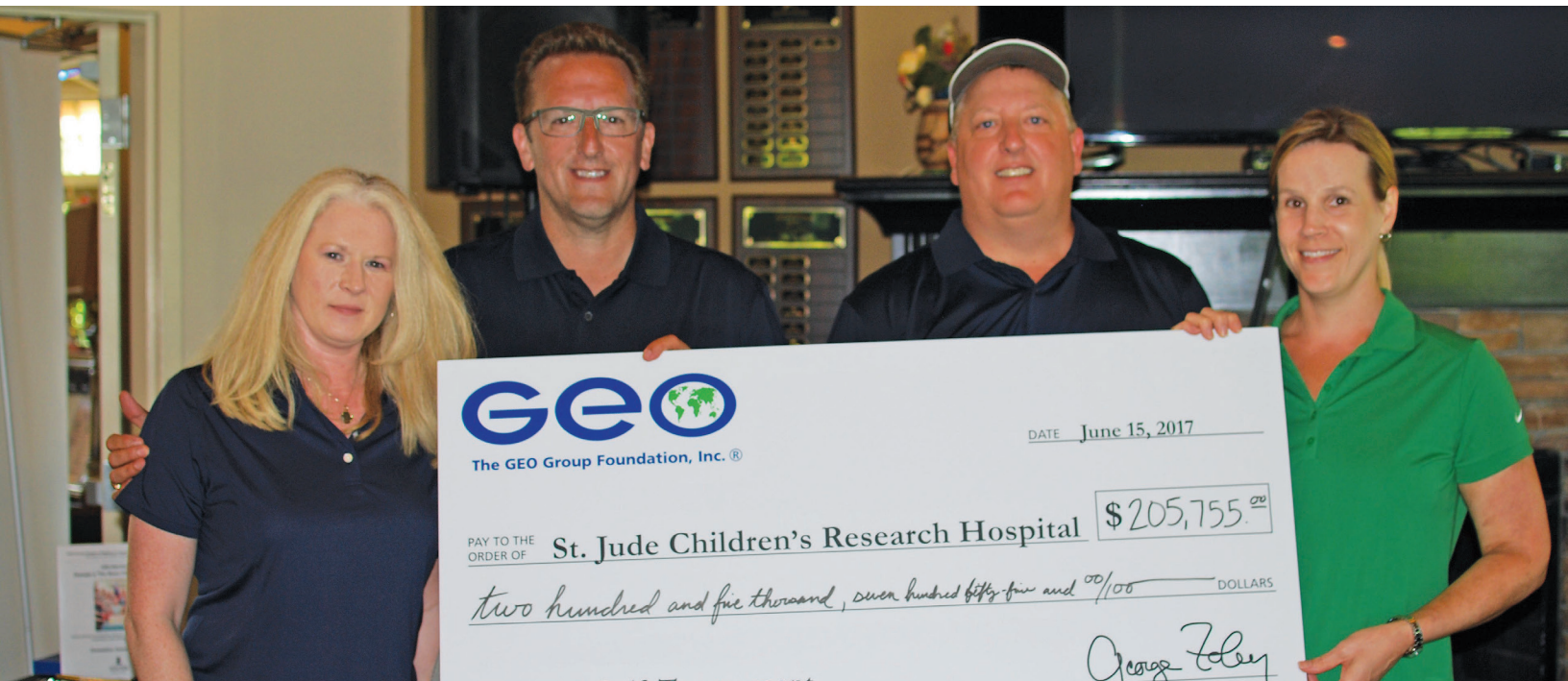
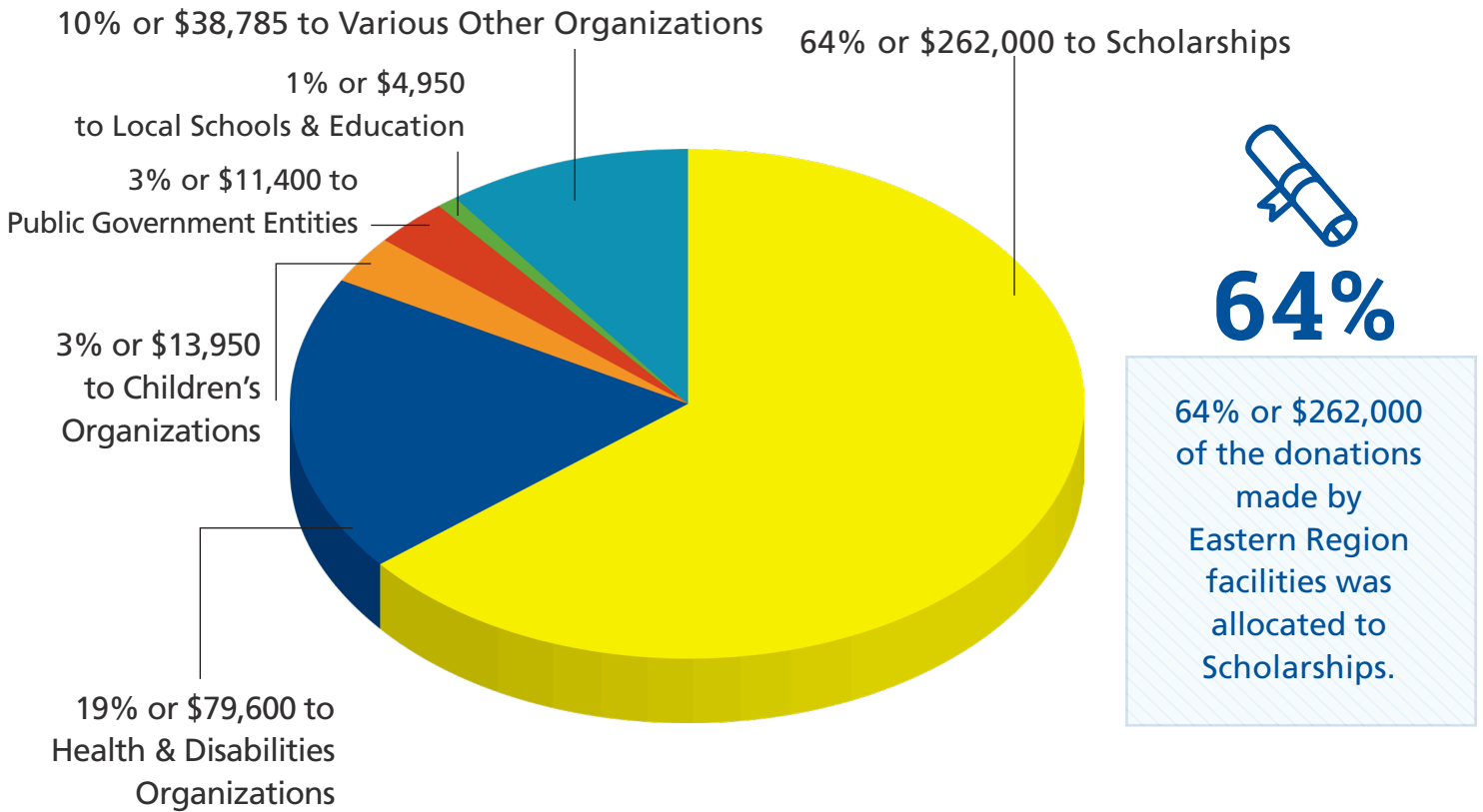
### Great Plains Supports The Lone Survivor Foundation

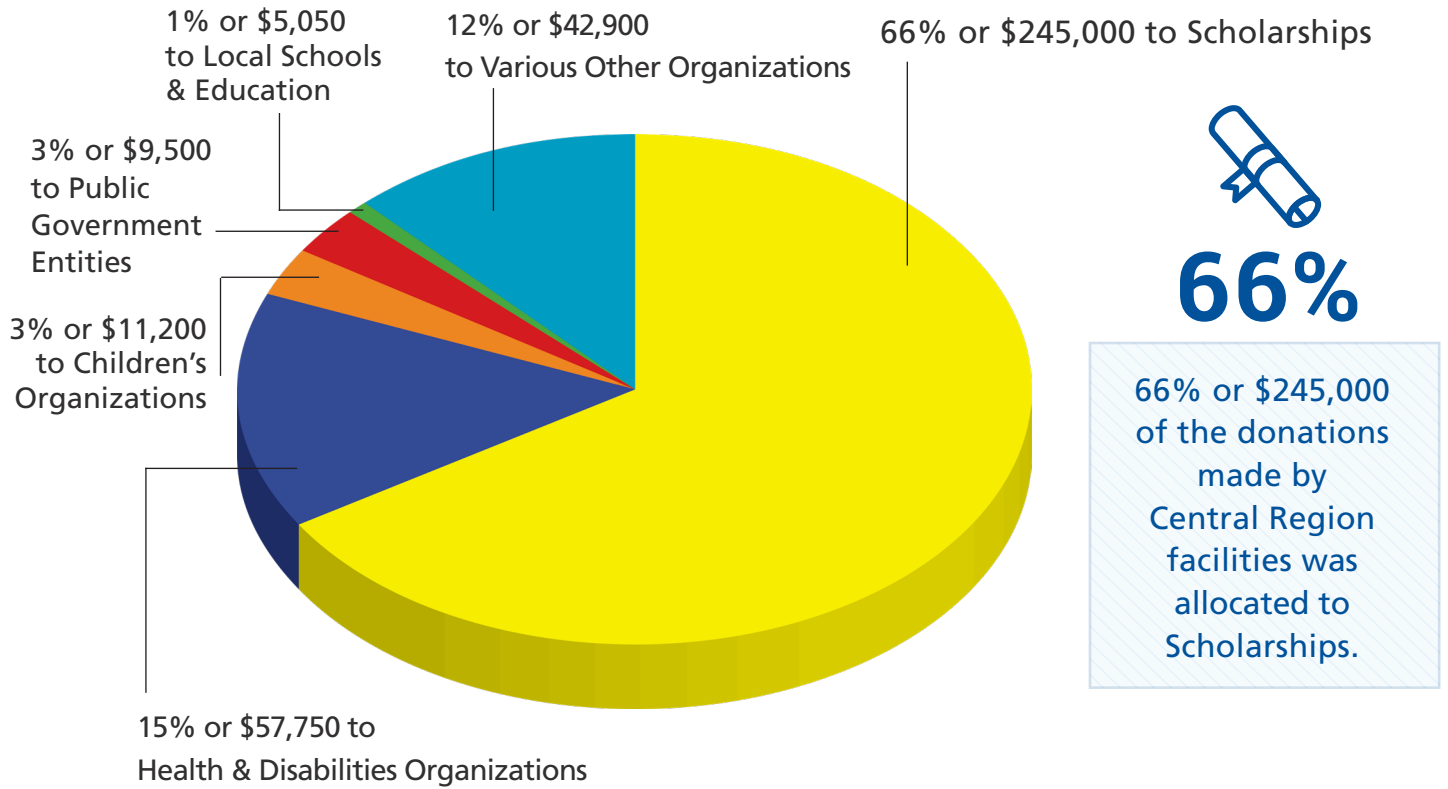
Eastern Region

**Total: \$410,685**



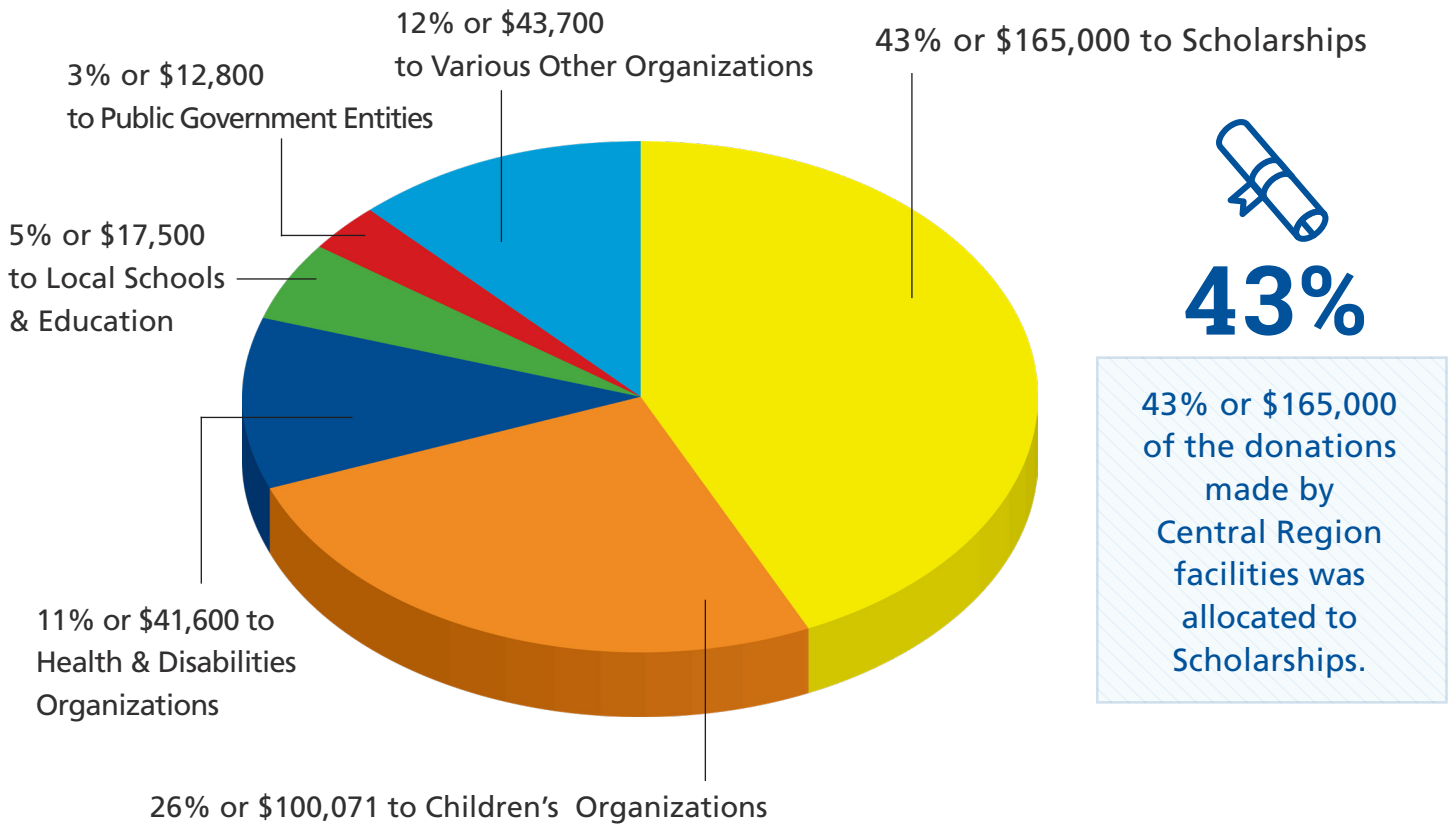
Central Region
